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


# **MHCC** District




The Mt. Hood Community College district encompasses an area of about 950 square miles with a population of more than 327,724 as of 2021. The district boundaries extend as far east as the lofty peak of Mt. Hood and to the Wasco County line, south into Clackamas County including the communities of Boring and Damascus and west into the city limits of Portland. The Columbia River from 33rd Street to Cascade Locks is the northern boundary. Included within this area are the high school districts of Centennial, Corbett, David Douglas, Gresham-Barlow, Oregon Trail, Parkrose, and Reynolds.













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#### MHCC Percentage of Students Receiving Pell Grants













– Attending MHCC the Year Following Their High School Graduation Year





# Unduplicated Headcount-to-FTE Ratio





## FTE by Course Type





## Annual Completions by Type and Year




