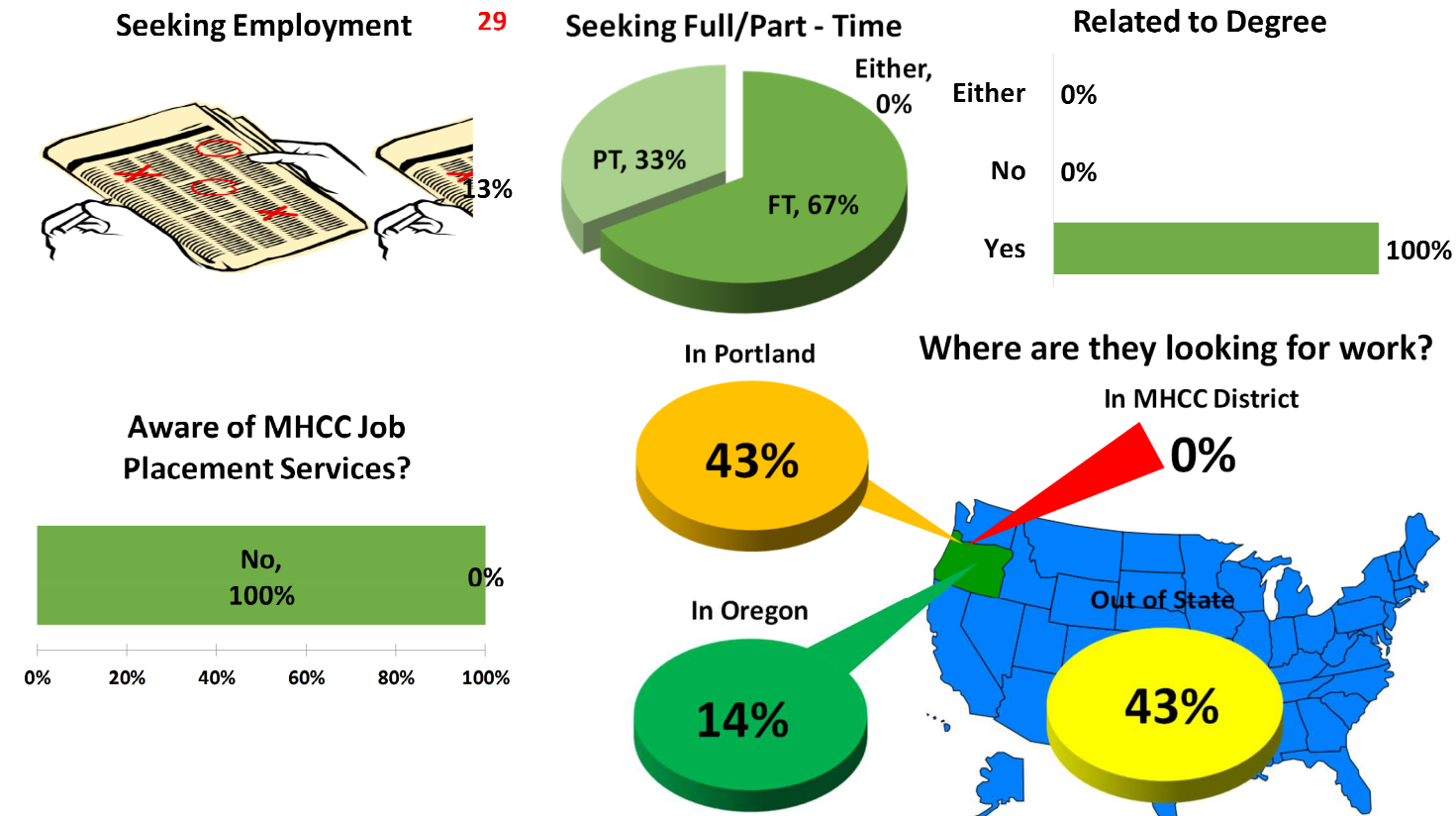

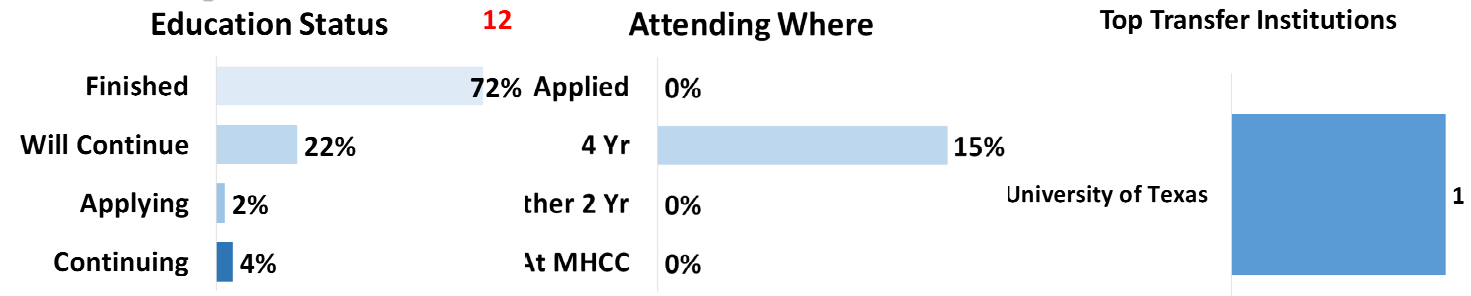
Percent Self Employed / Independent Contractor:



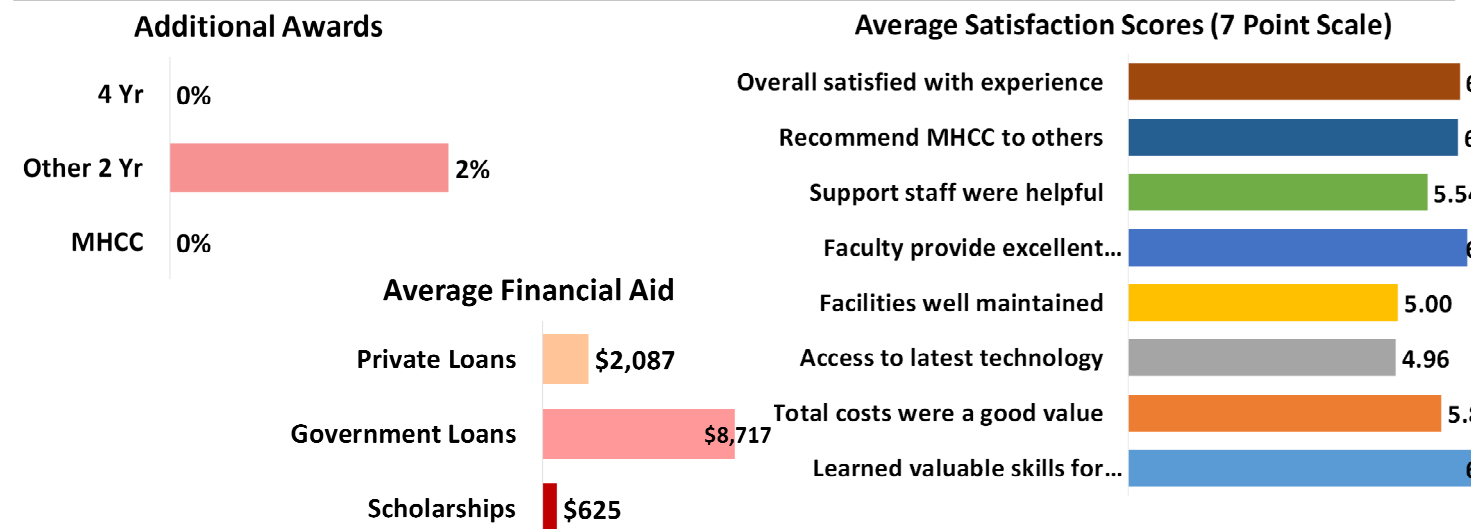
Job Seekers Respondents Indicating They Are Looking for Work: 6



Continuing Education Respondents Indicating They Are Continuing Education: 2



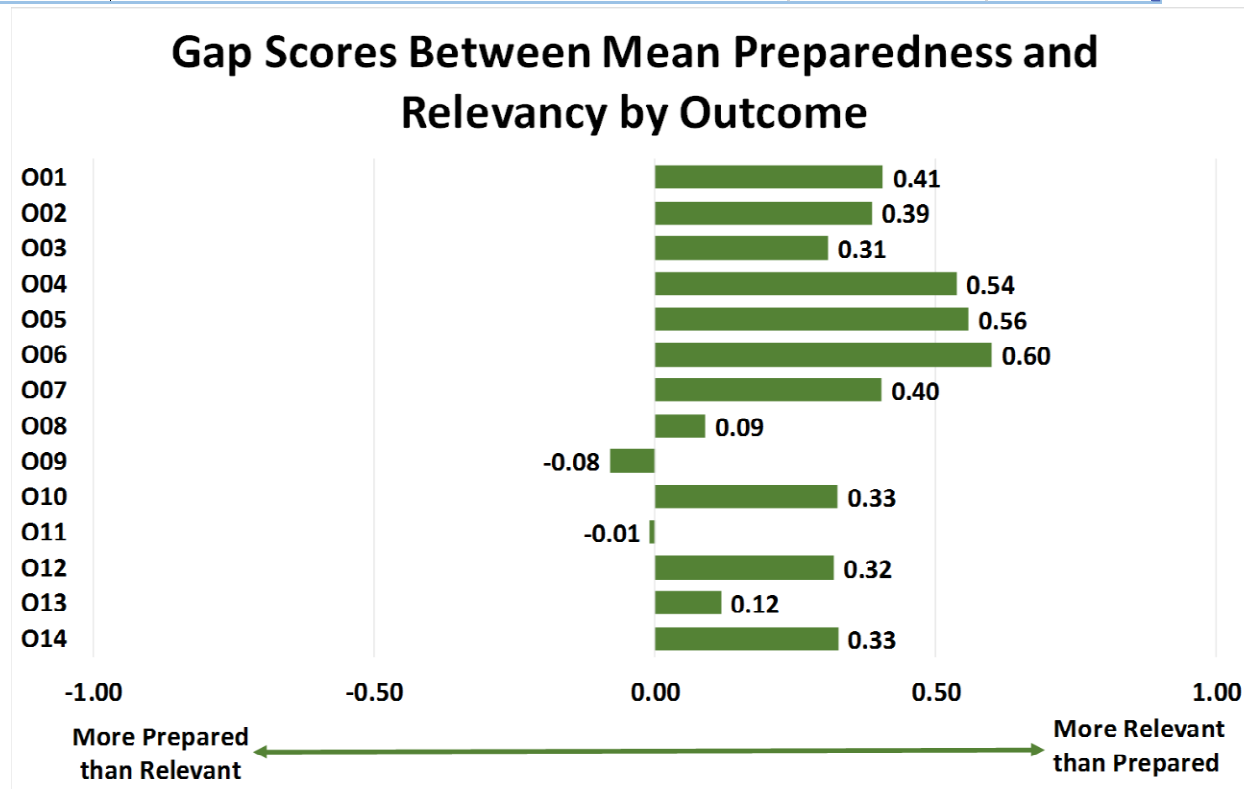

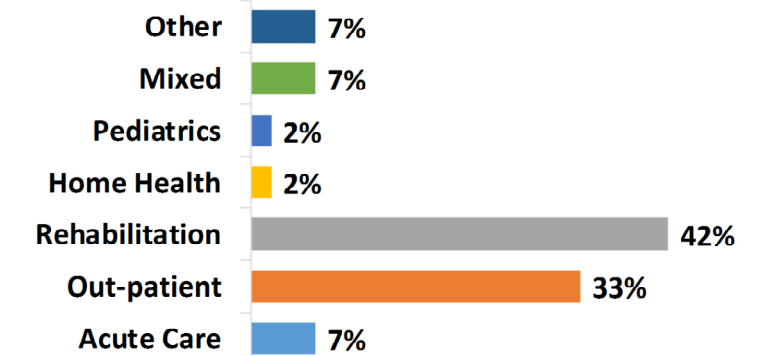

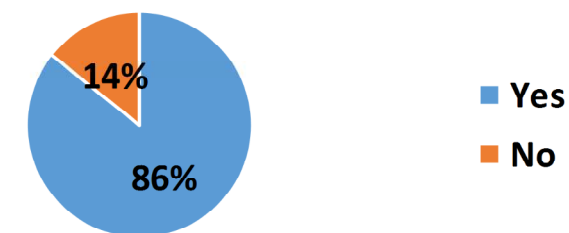
Employed As A PTA?



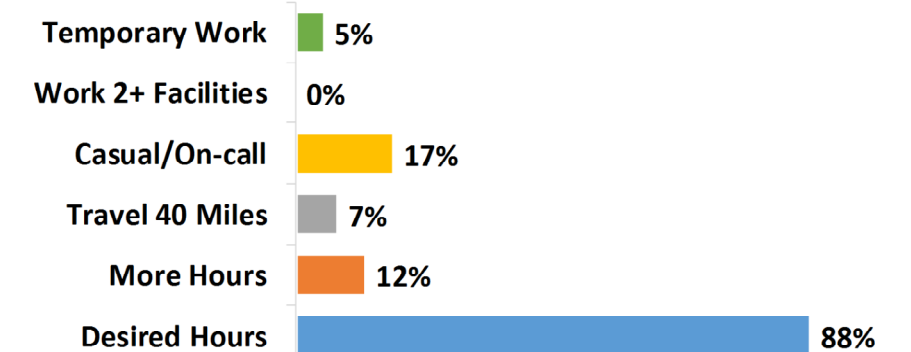
Practice Setting

Please share any barriers or experiences related to your PTA employment search that you would like us to know?

- * I found employment quickly in my area with minimal barriers.
- * A shortage of full time jobs that do not require working weekends. Job market tighter than anticipated.
- * The job market for PTAs seems to be somewhat tight at this time.
- * Starting my search early paid off for me. I feel that my willingness to work under a temp license made me more marketable and competitive to prospective employers than those who chose to wait to find work until after boards. It took a lot of stress off me to not have to worry about job searching while studying. I am 100% satisfied with all aspects of my job/place of employment.

Is there anything else you'd like to tell us to help enhance the preparation of future MHCC PTA graduates or those exploring this as a career option?

* I don't believe so. I felt fully prepared.

* Having a great boss and team is more important than which company you work for, and each facility is different. If you have a bad impression of the people who interview you, you probably won't enjoy working for them.
