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Introduction

Editions of the MHCC Fact Book prior to 2013-2014 used enrollment figures based on the fourth week of fall term. The basic difference between fourth week and end-of-term is that the latter includes a relatively higher number of noncredit and continuing education students.

In 2013-2014 the fact book was redesigned and reformatted to provide an annual look with data being reported at the end of the school year. Relevant data are being stored in a single location to assure consistency in the analysis and reporting; comparisons to previous editions of the fact book may show inconsistencies. The design of this new version of the fact book includes:

- fact book now include a chart to graphically display the information.
- Finally, Staffing Level data is presented.
- The presentation is consistent across all variables assessed.

The current year's student demographics is followed by comparisons of these demographics to the four previous years. This is followed by enrollment trends data which looks at changes to enrollment over time. Annual enrollment and completions data is next. The fact book then reports statewide comparisons (MHCC compared to the sixteen other Oregon Community Colleges).

> A consistent presentation. Where comparisons are made on annual data, the most recent data is compared to data from the previous four years. This provides the opportunity to see trends in the data.

> Where percentages are shown the total percent may not add up to 100% due to rounding.








MHCC Student Profile – Annual Enrollment












Enrollment Patterns – 5 Year Annual Enrollment








Credit Load Distribution









Unduplicated Head Count to FTE Ratio








Statewide CC District Property Tax Revenue by Year










Statewide and MHCC Financial Aid Awards by Year




