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Welcome to the Mt. Hood Community College (MHCC) Fact Book. In the pages of this booklet, you'll find information on MHCC enrollment data, student demographics, student profiles based on credit load and other factors, financial aid awards, statewide community college appropriations, and more. This data provides a data-based overview of the students we serve, their educational goals and intents, our state and tax revenue funding, and financial aid distribution.

Editions of the MHCC Fact Book prior to 2013-14 use enrollment figures based on the fourth week of the fall term. The basic difference between using the fourth week and the end of the term is that end-of-term data includes a relatively higher number of noncredit and continuing education students.

Beginning in 2013-14, the Fact Book was redesigned and reformatted to provide an annual look at data being reported at the end of the school year. Relevant data are being stored in a single location to assure consistency in the analysis. Reporting comparisons of previous editions of the Fact Book may show inconsistencies. The design of this new version includes:

- A graphic presentation of data, retained from the previous version. Nearly all data represented in the Fact Book now includes a chart to graphically display the information.
- Annual data rather than a snapshot of the fourth-week fall data. The data has been organized to provide a more logical flow. The current year's student demographic information is followed by comparisons of these demographics to the four previous years. This is followed by enrollment trends data, which looks at changes to enrollment over time. Annual enrollment and completions data follows. The Fact Book then reports statewide comparisons (MHCC compared to 16 other Oregon community colleges). Finally, staffing data is presented.
- Where comparisons are made to annual data, the most recent data is compared to data from the previous four years. This provides opportunity to see trends in the data. The presentation is consistent across all variable assets.
- Where percentages are shown, the total percent may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.

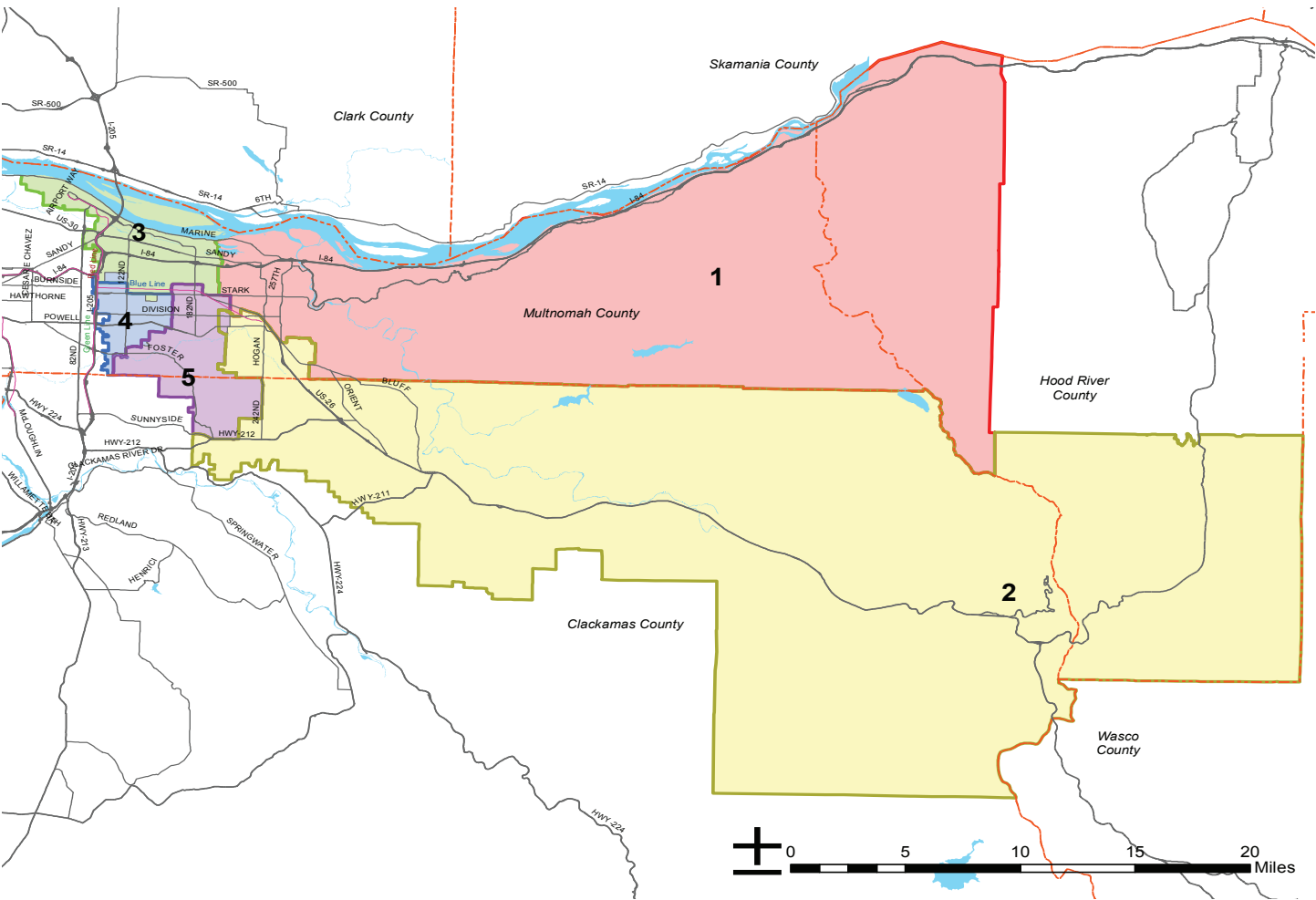

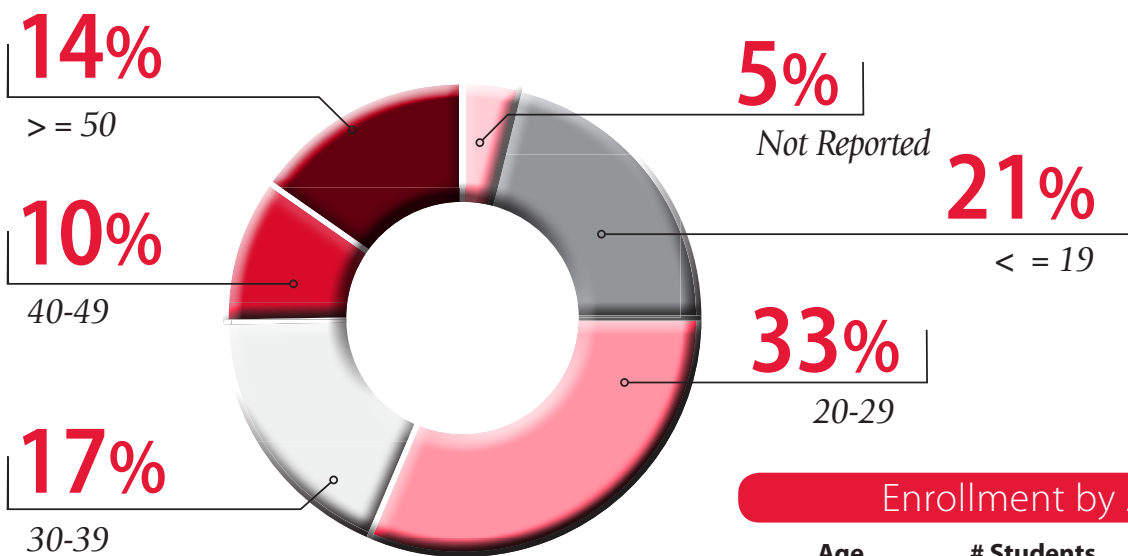
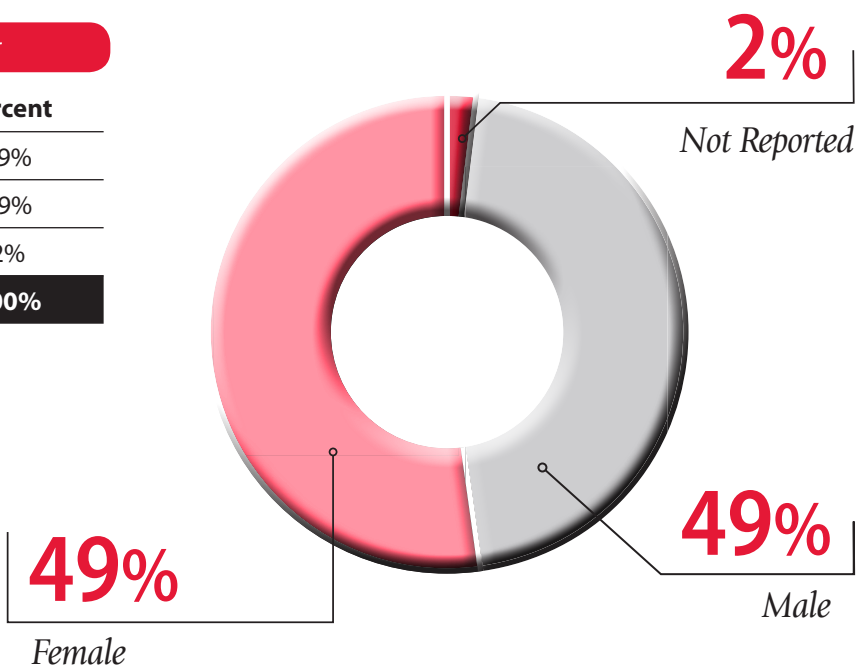
The Mt. Hood Community College district encompasses an area of about 950 square miles with a population of more than 327,676. The district boundaries extend as far east as the lofty peak of Mt. Hood and to the Wasco County line, south into Clackamas County including the communities of Boring and Damascus and west into the city limits of Portland. The Columbia River from 33rd Street. to Cascade Locks is the northern boundary. Included within this area are the high school districts of Centennial, Corbett, David Douglas, Gresham-Barlow, Oregon Trail, Parkrose, and Reynolds.

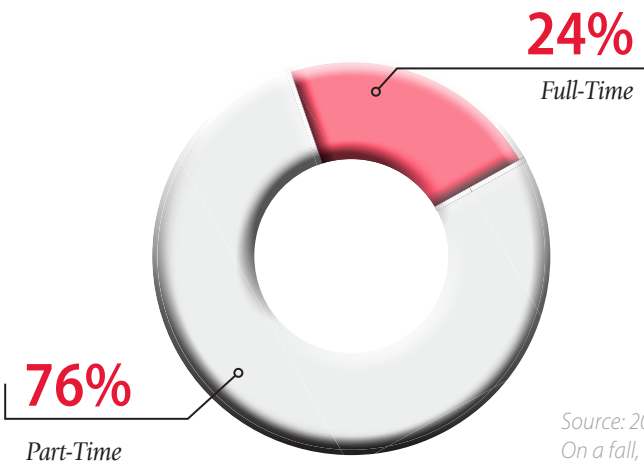
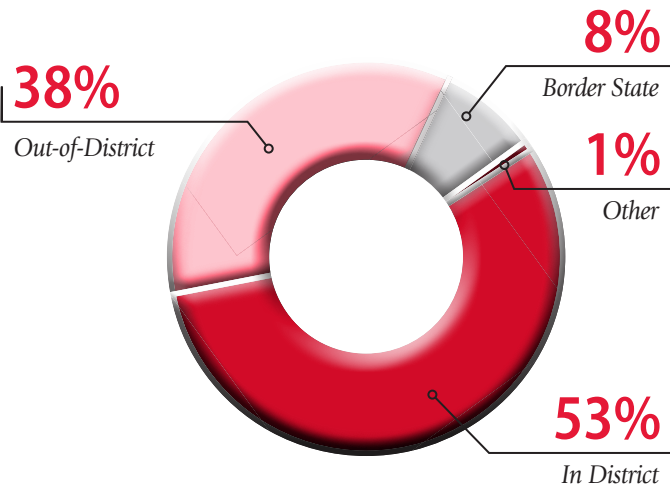

Enrollment by Full/Part Time

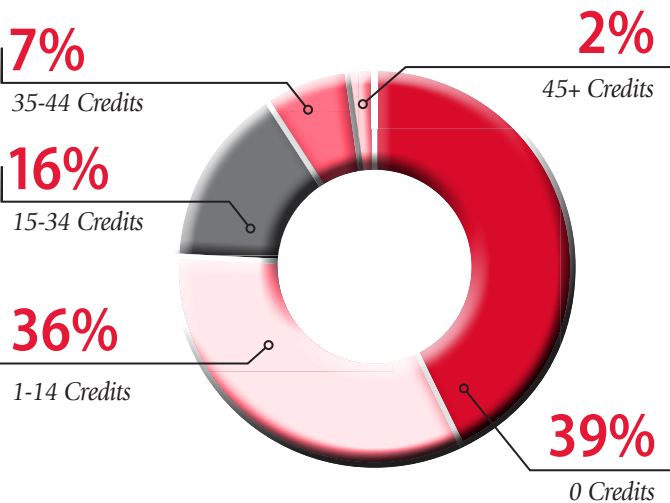

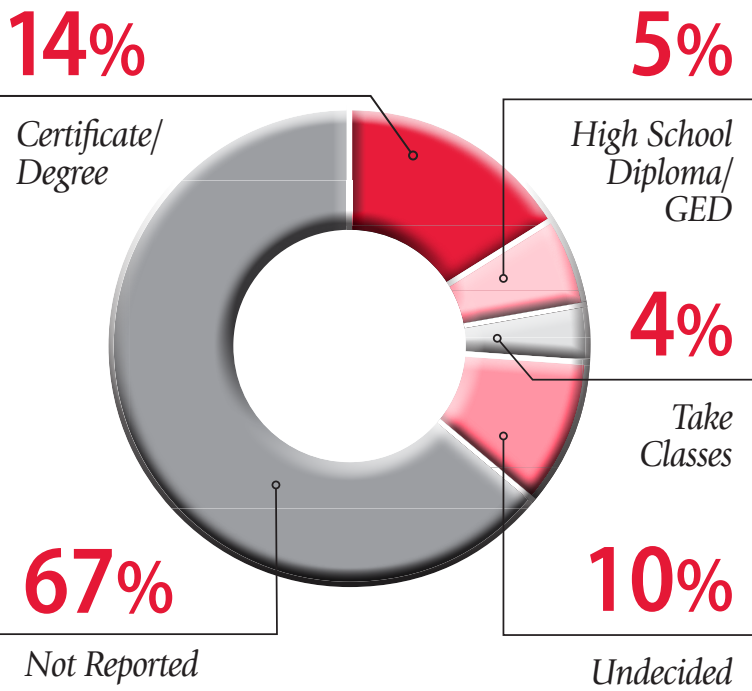

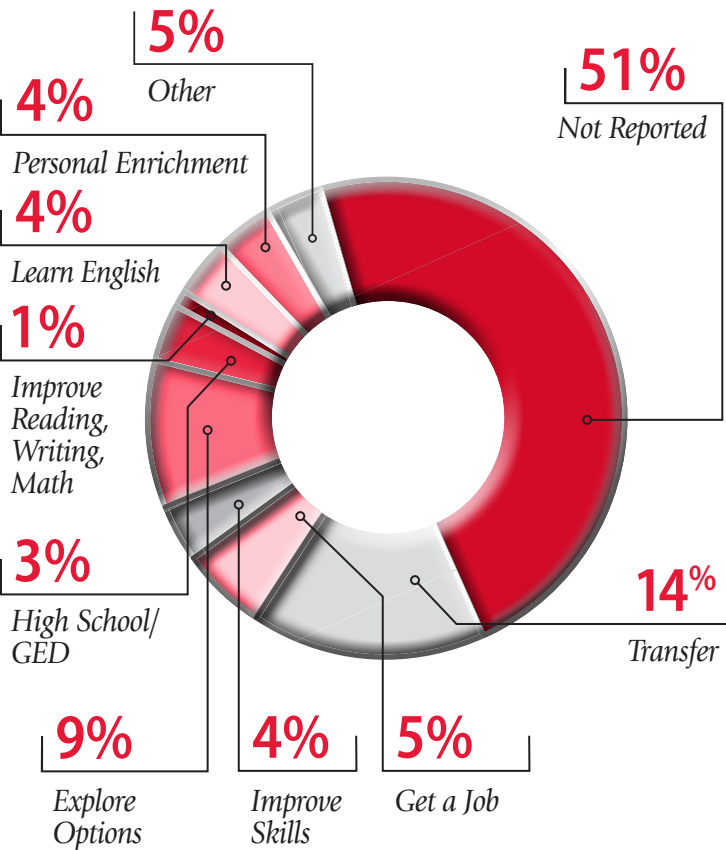

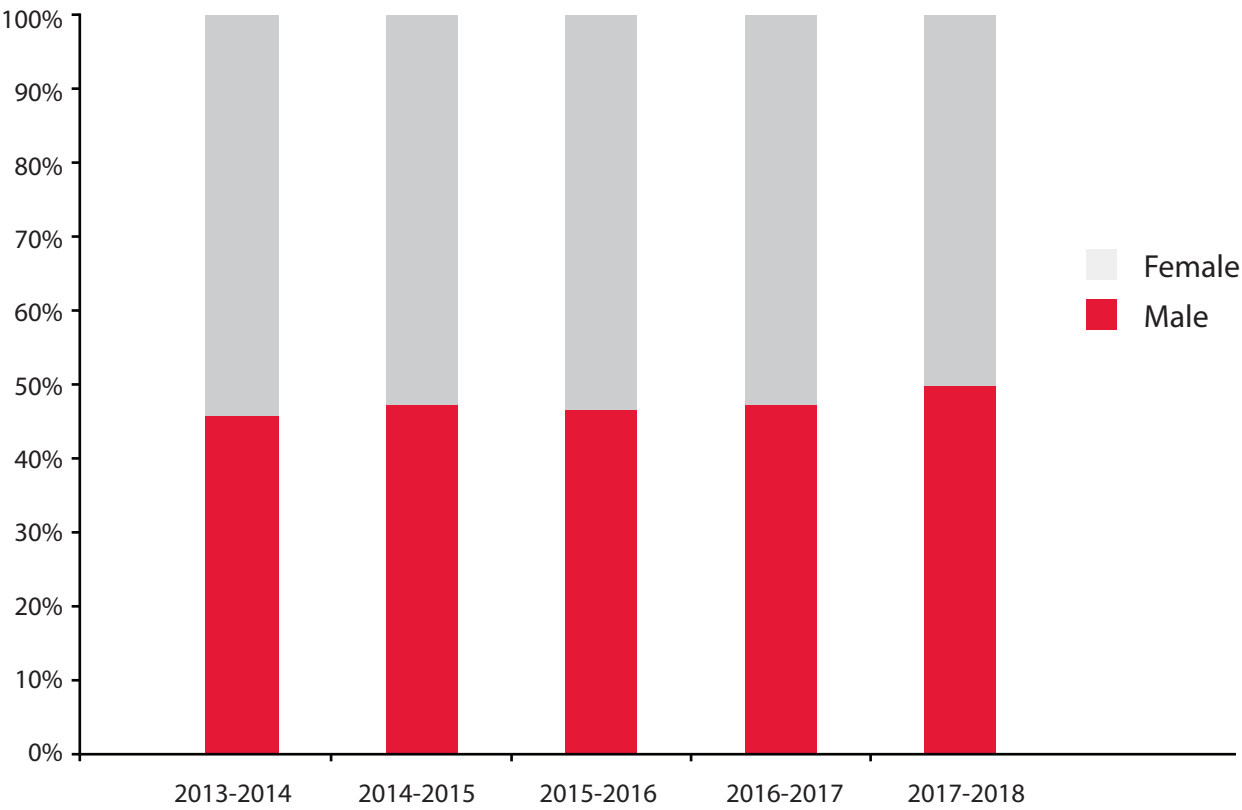

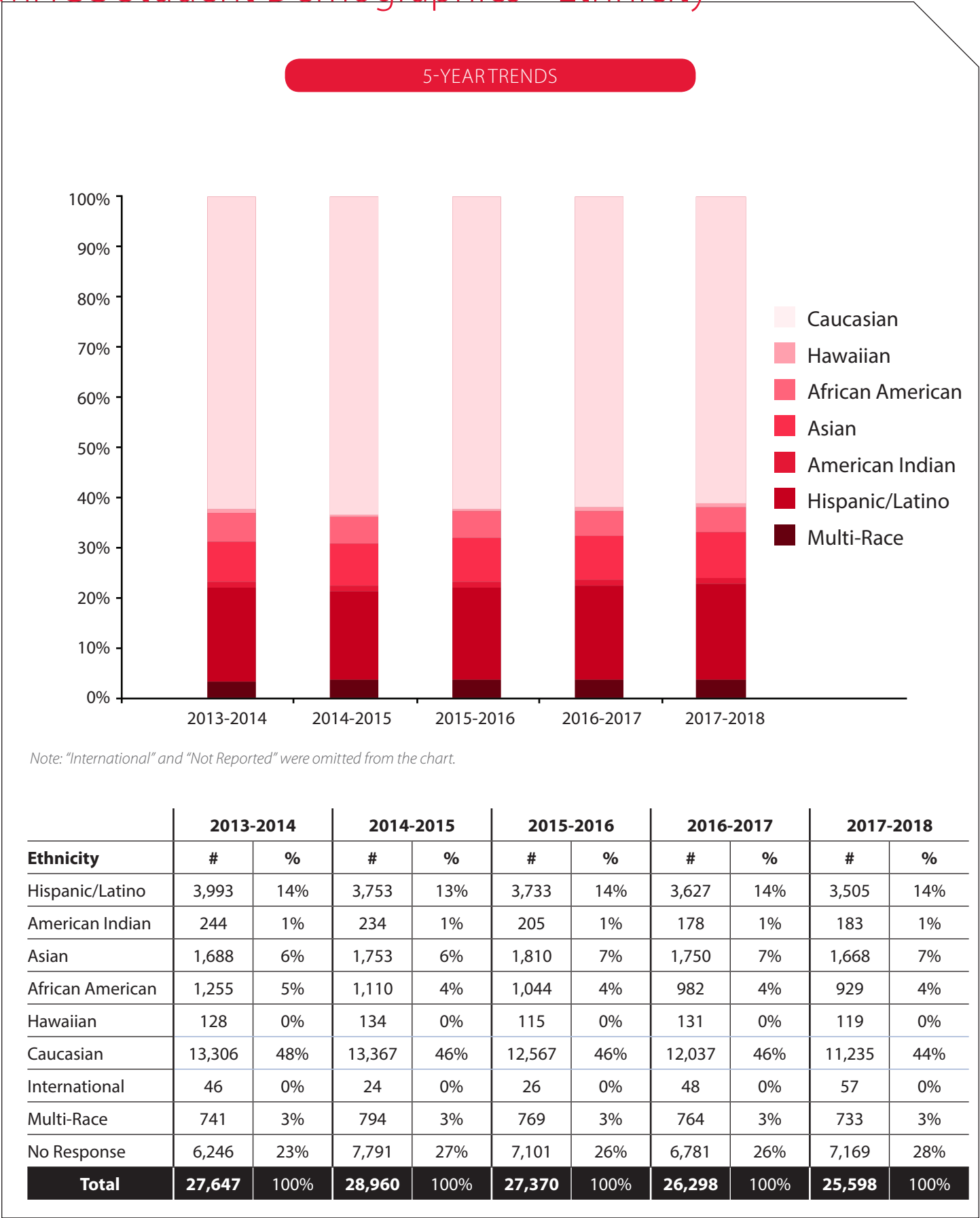

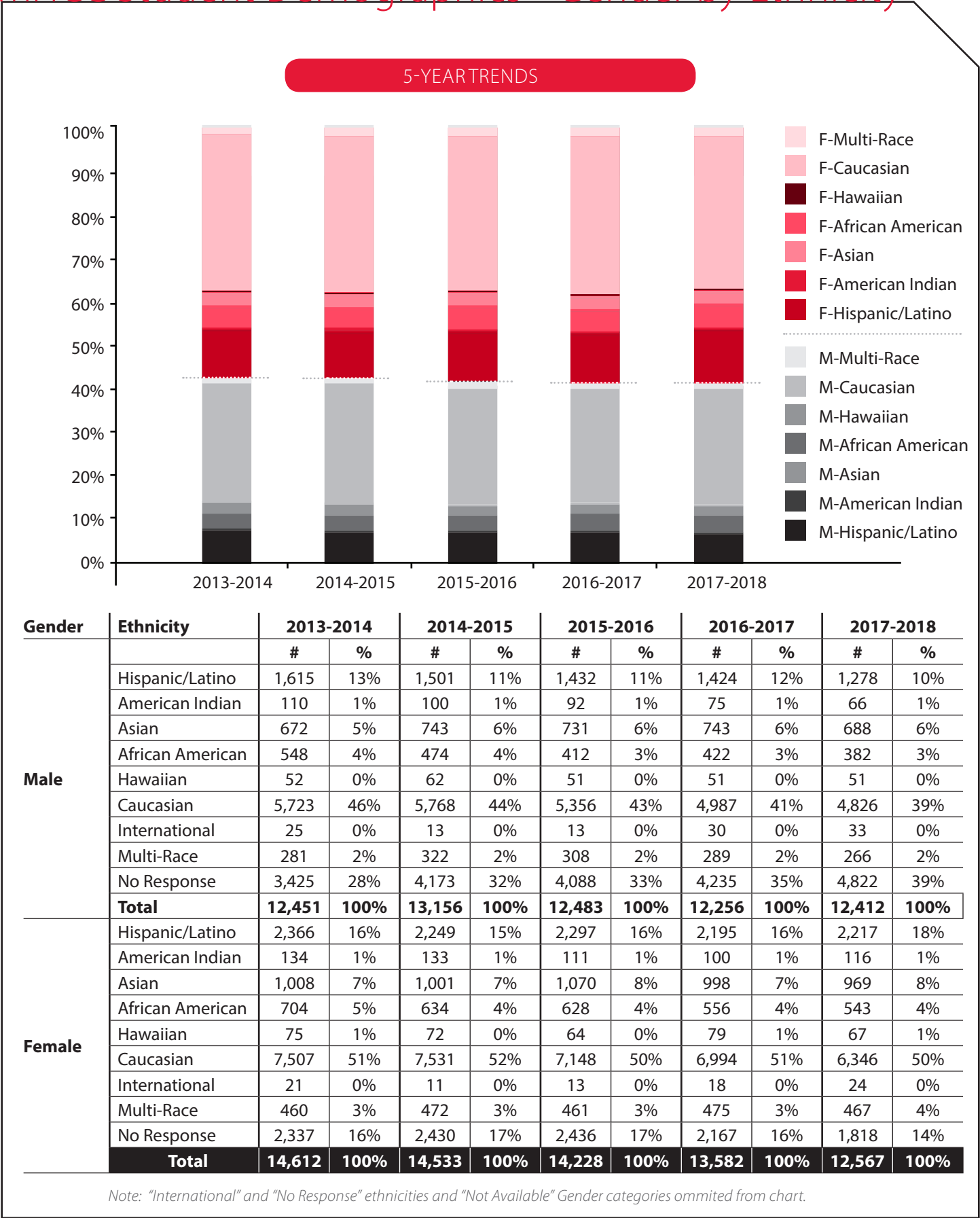

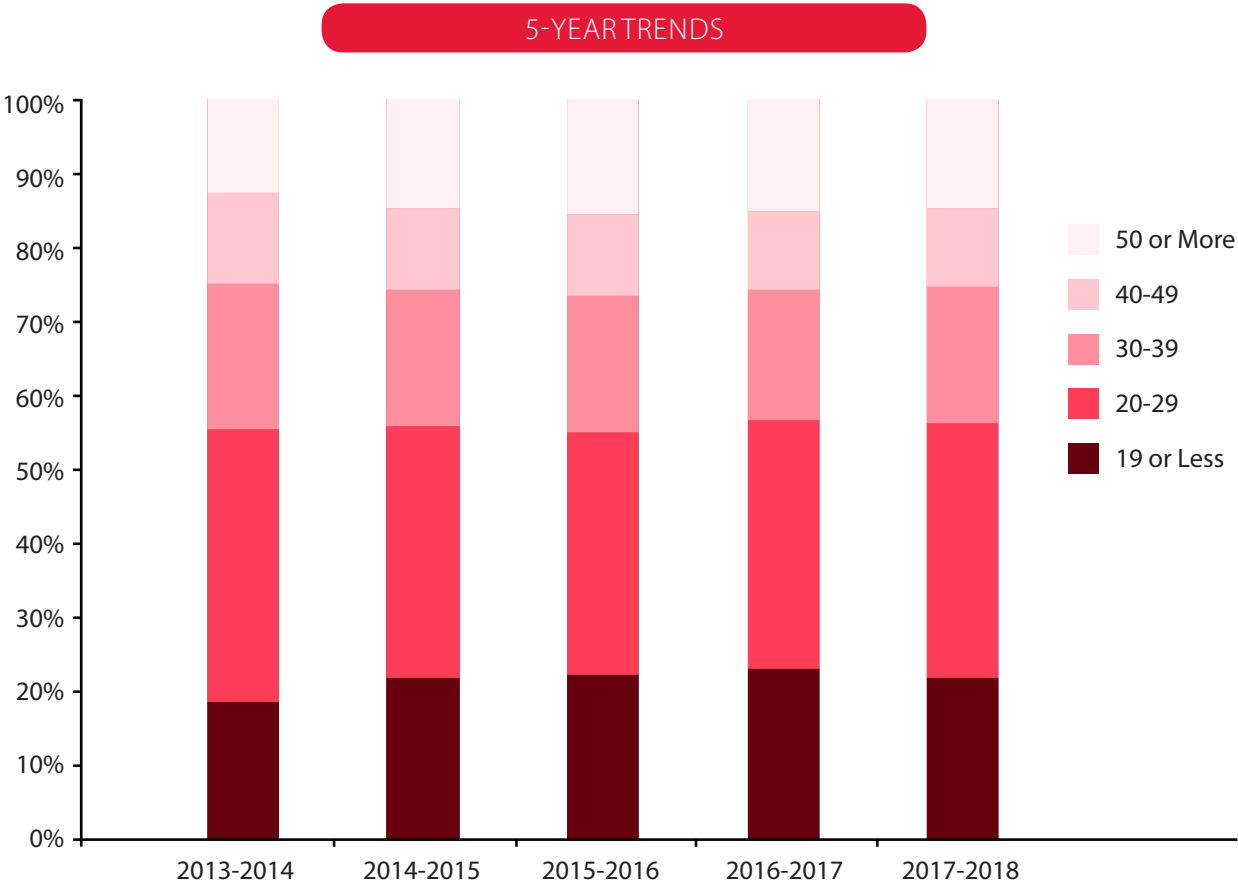
MHCC Student Demographics - Ethnicity



MHCC Student Demographics - Gender by Ethnicity



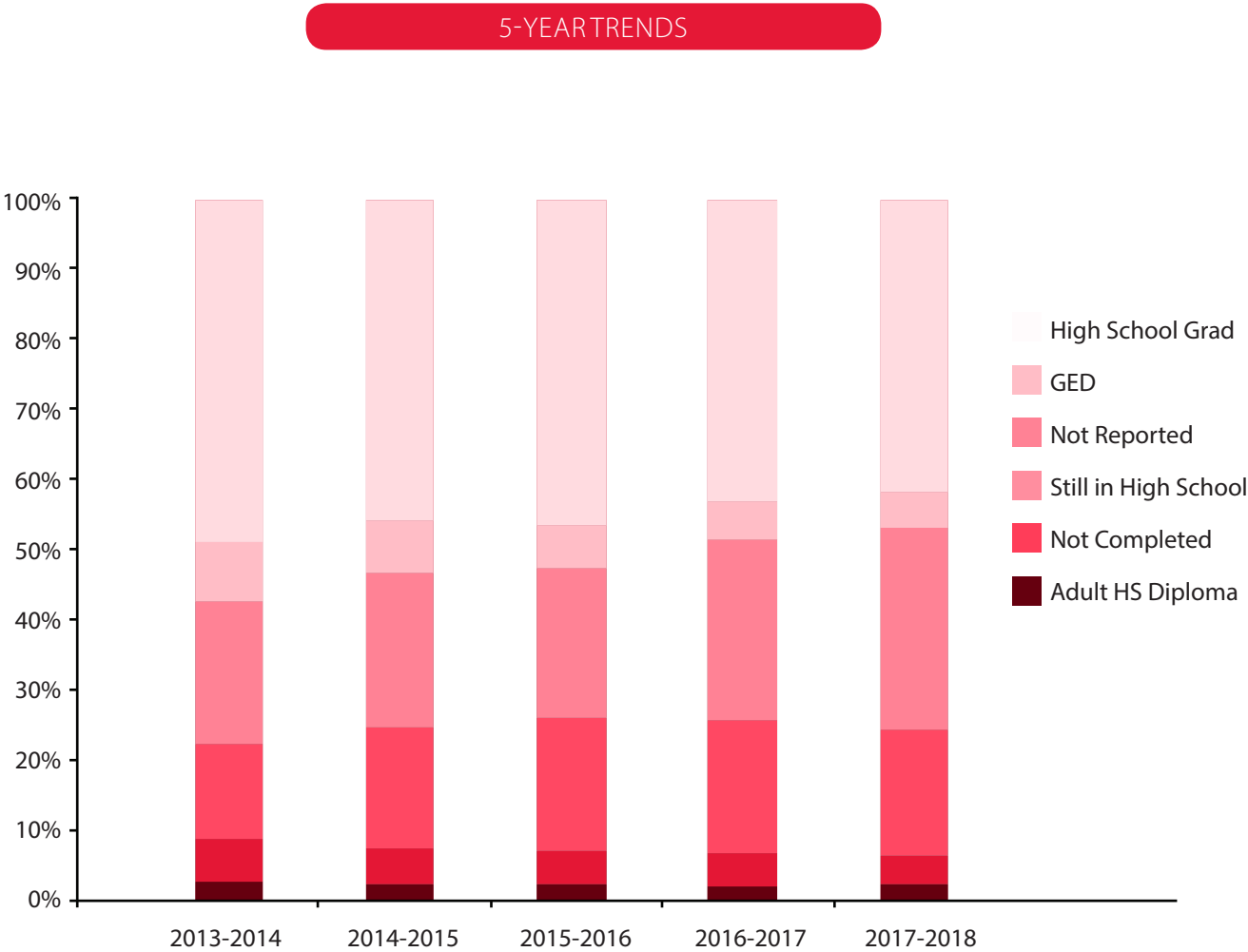
MHCC Student Demographics - Age

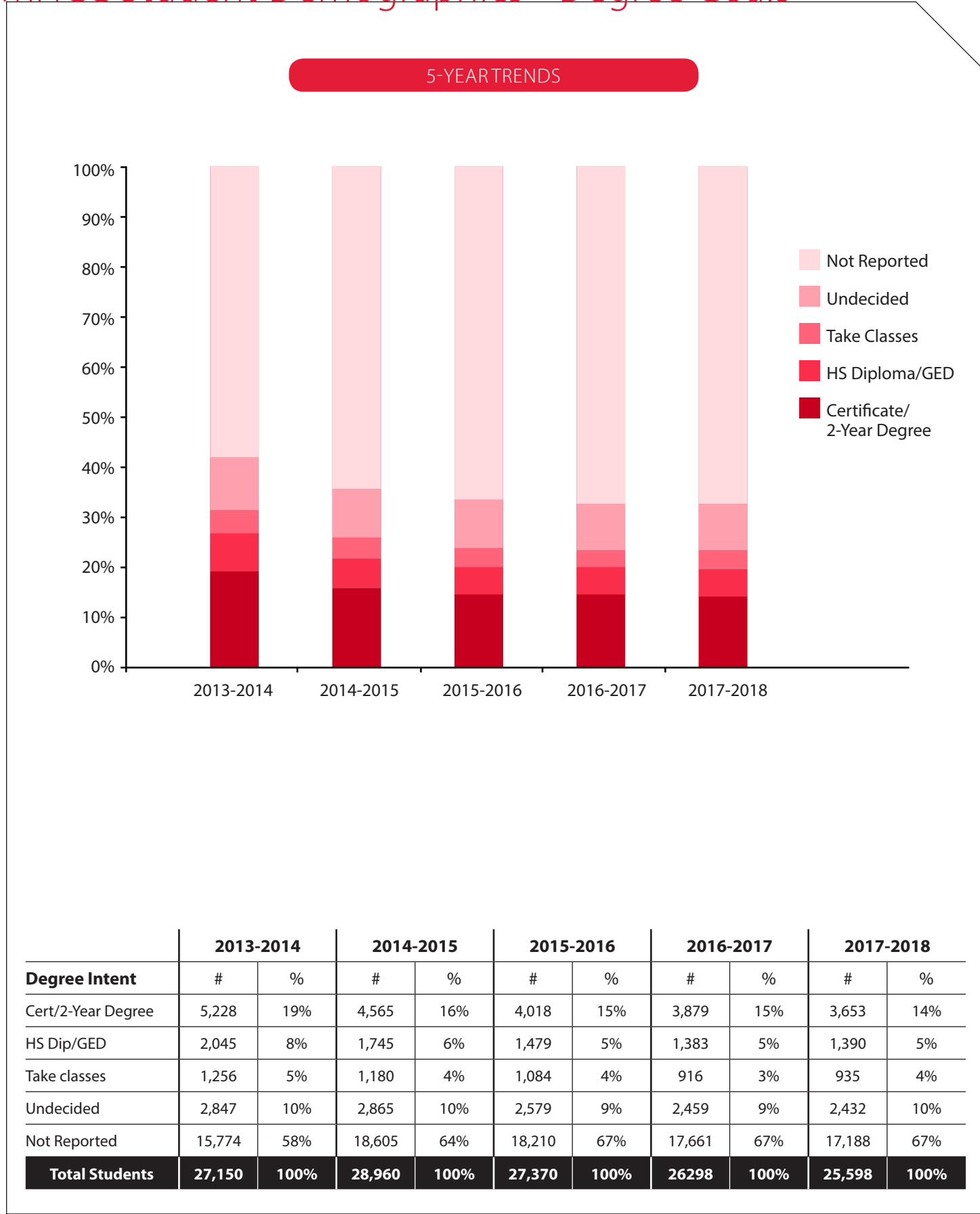

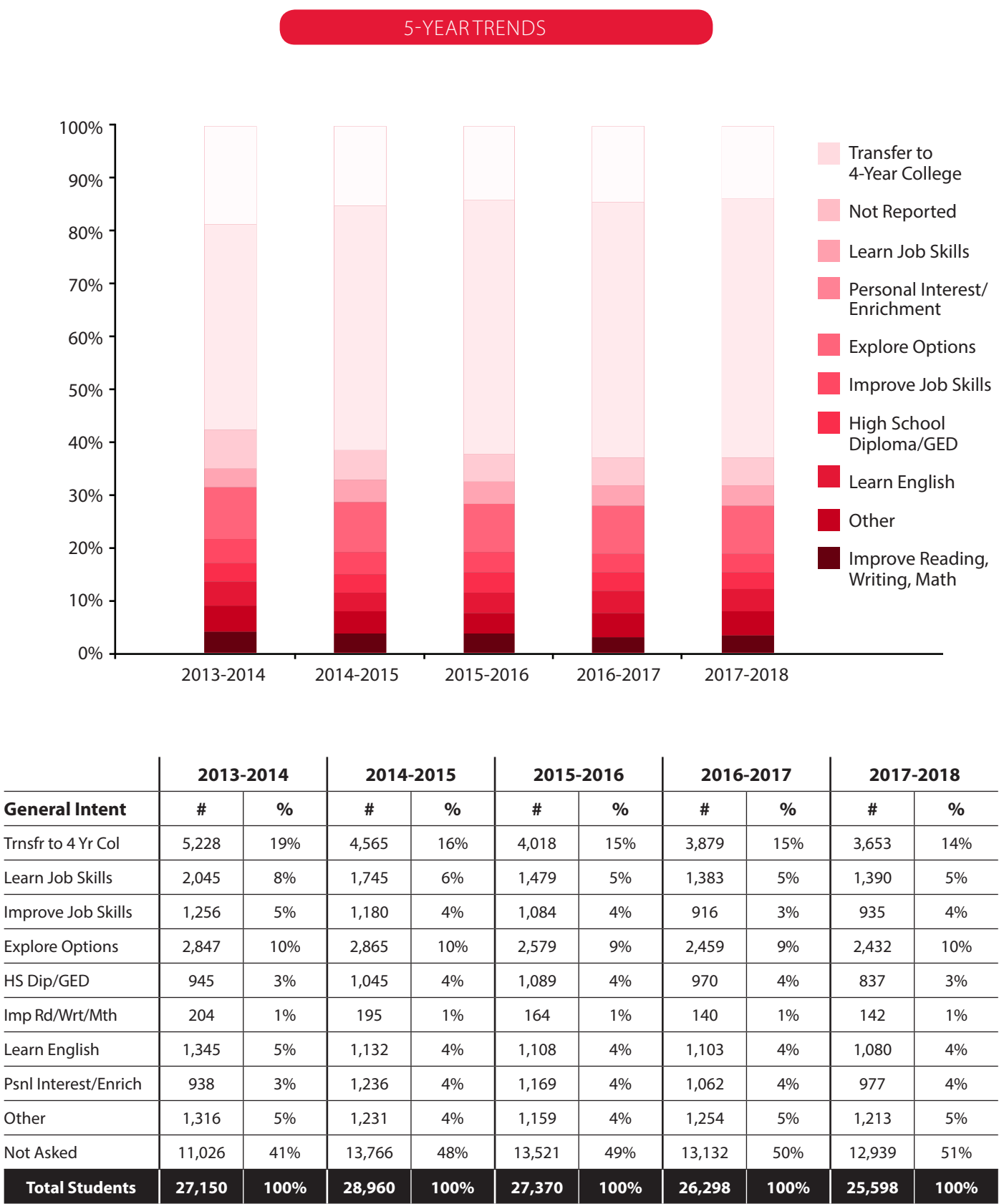

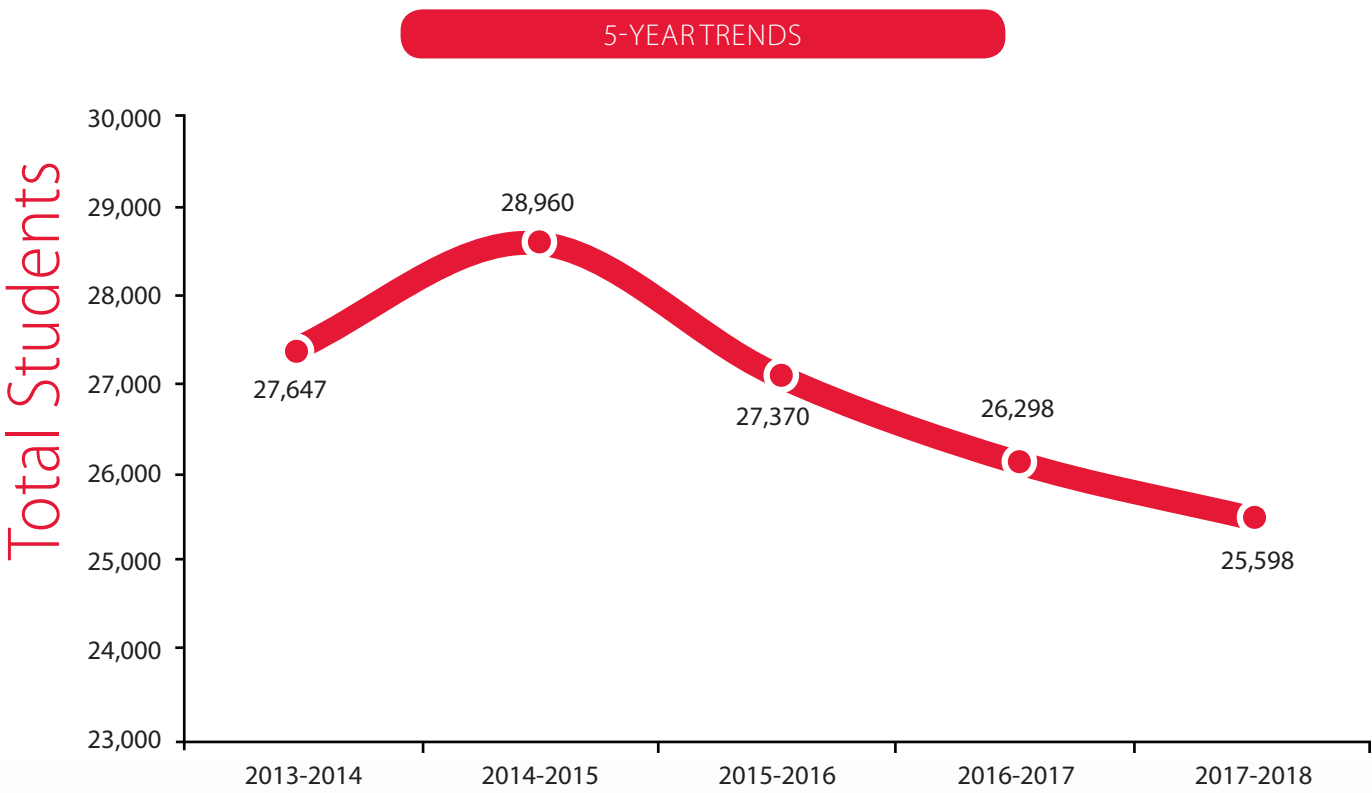
MHCC Student Demographics - Degree Goals



MHCC Student Demographics- General Intent



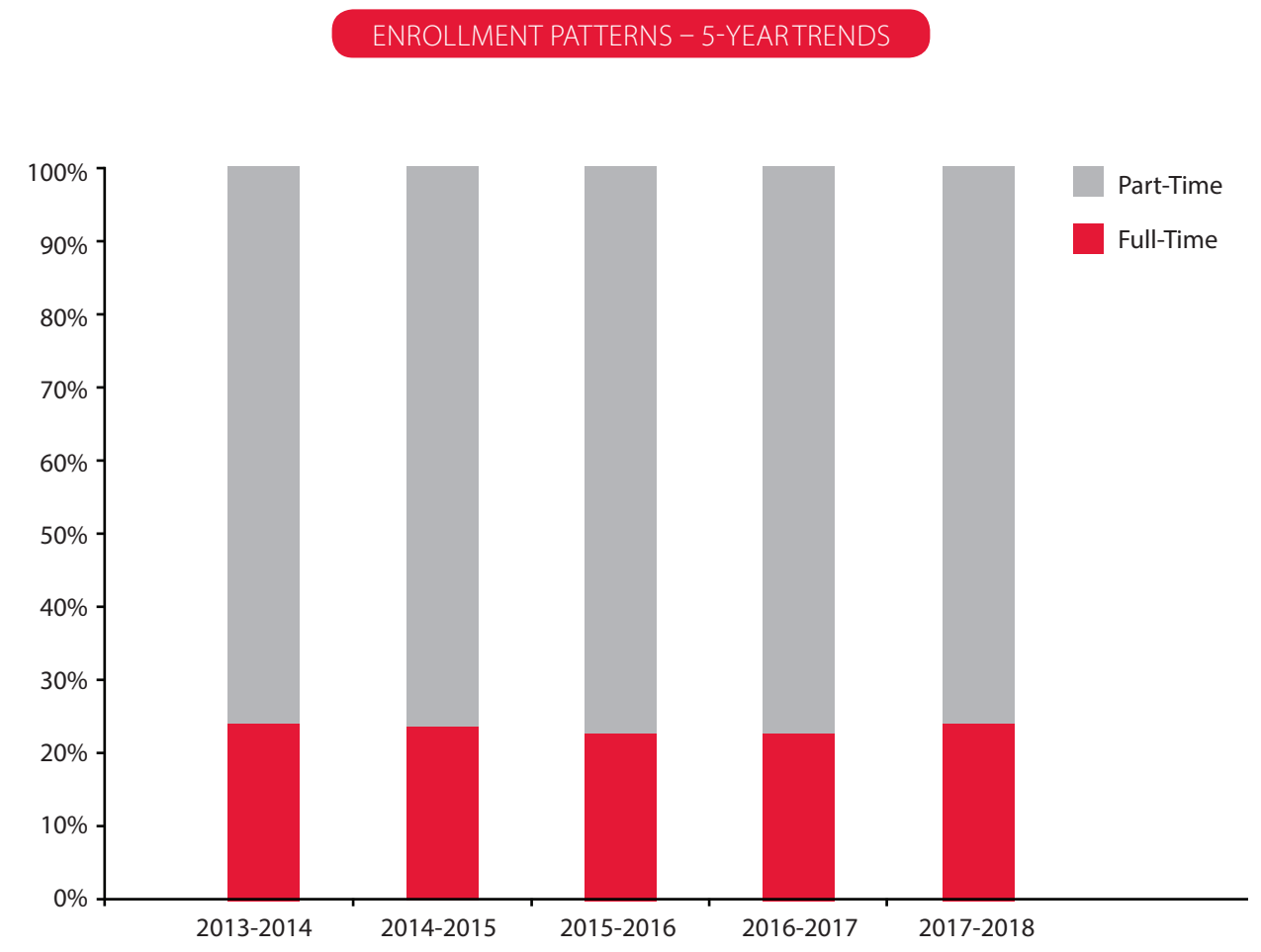
Enrollment Patterns - 5 Year Annual Enrollment

Full-Time/Part-Time Enrollment



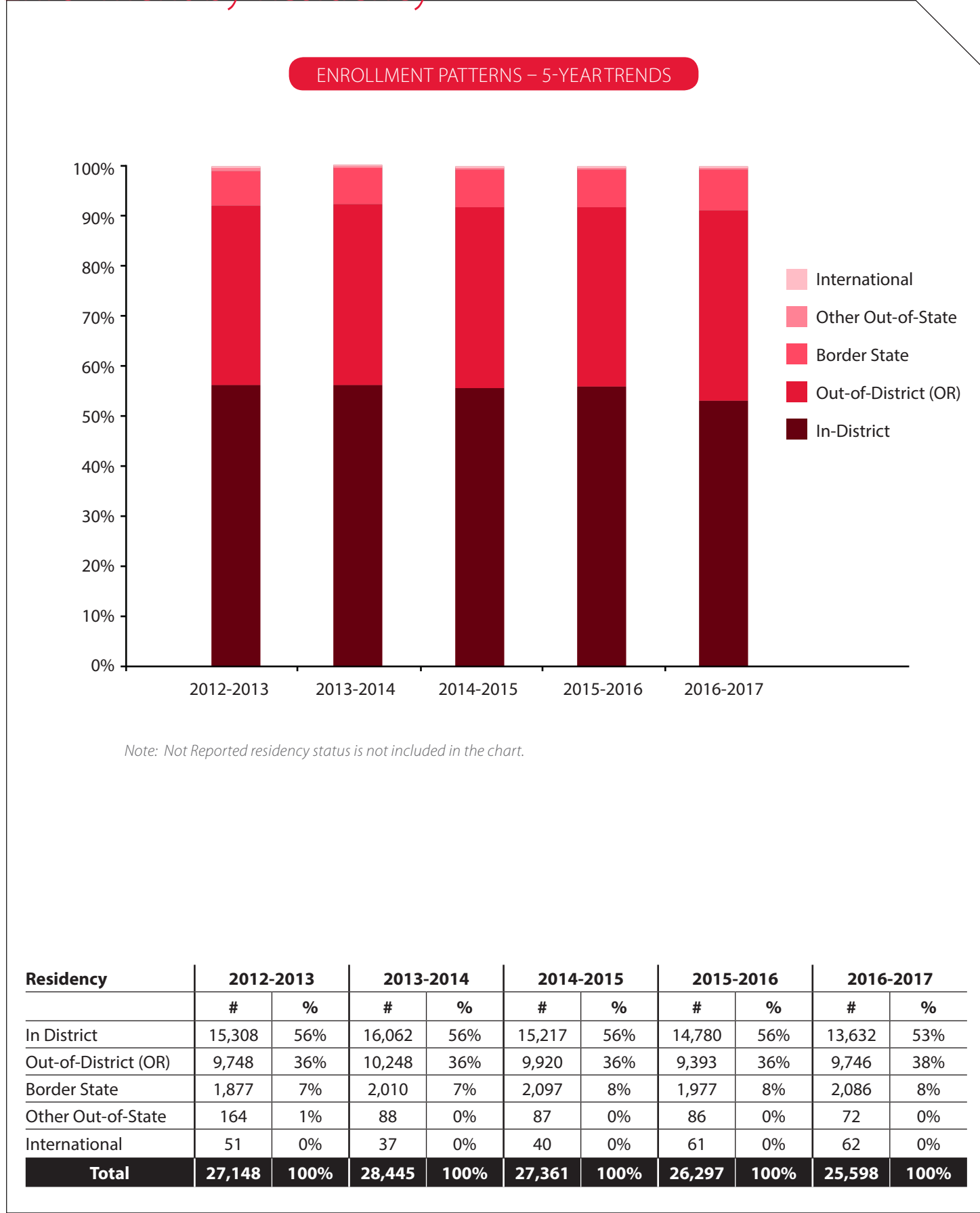

Credit Load Distribution



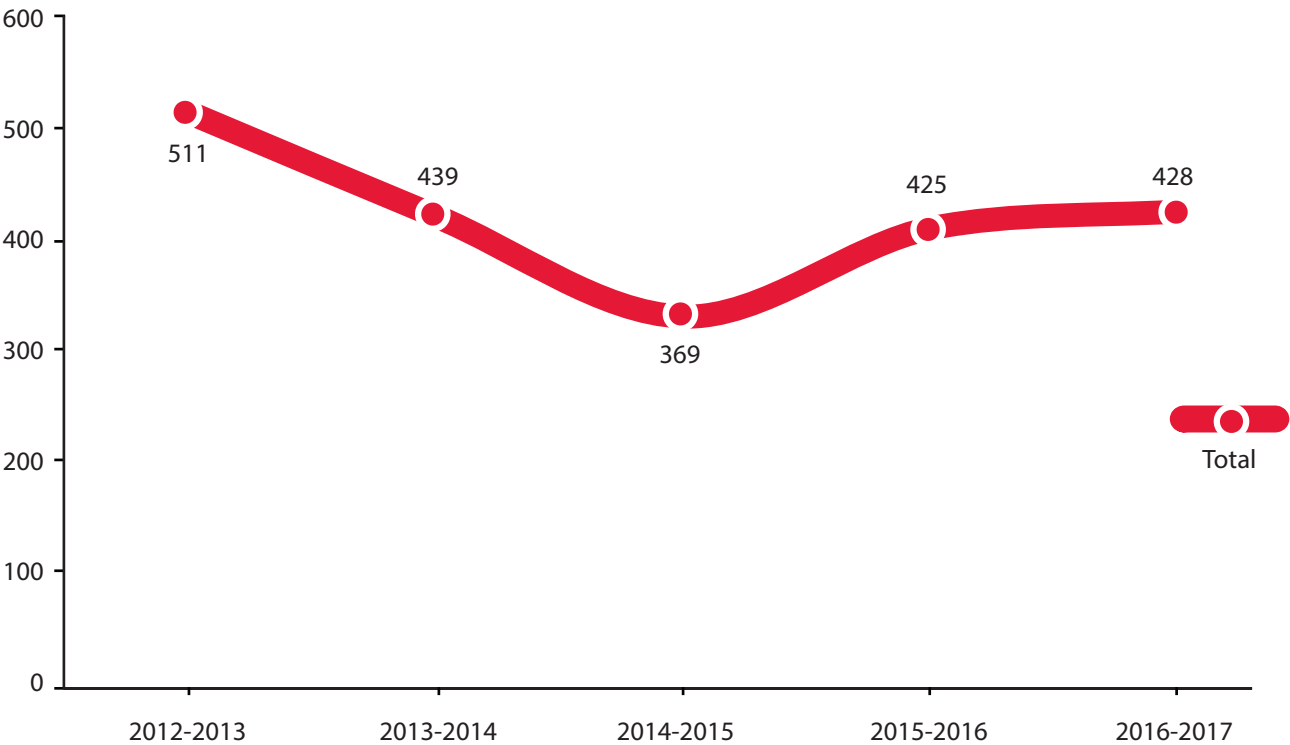
Enrollment by Residency

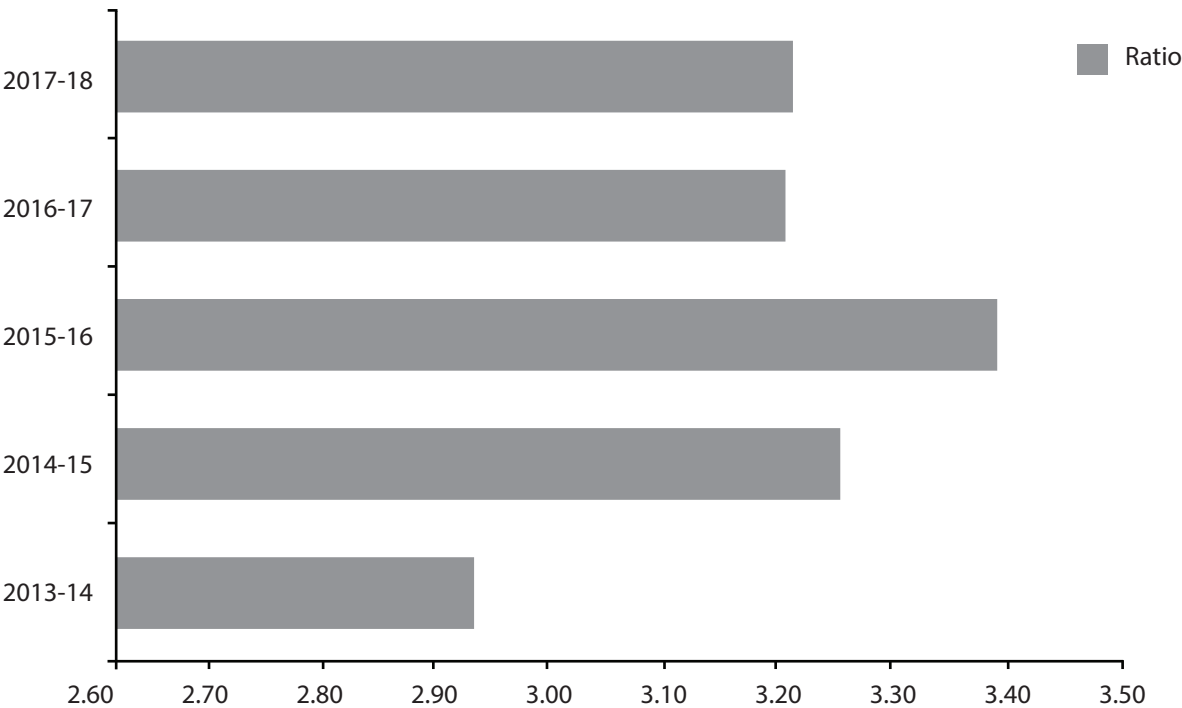

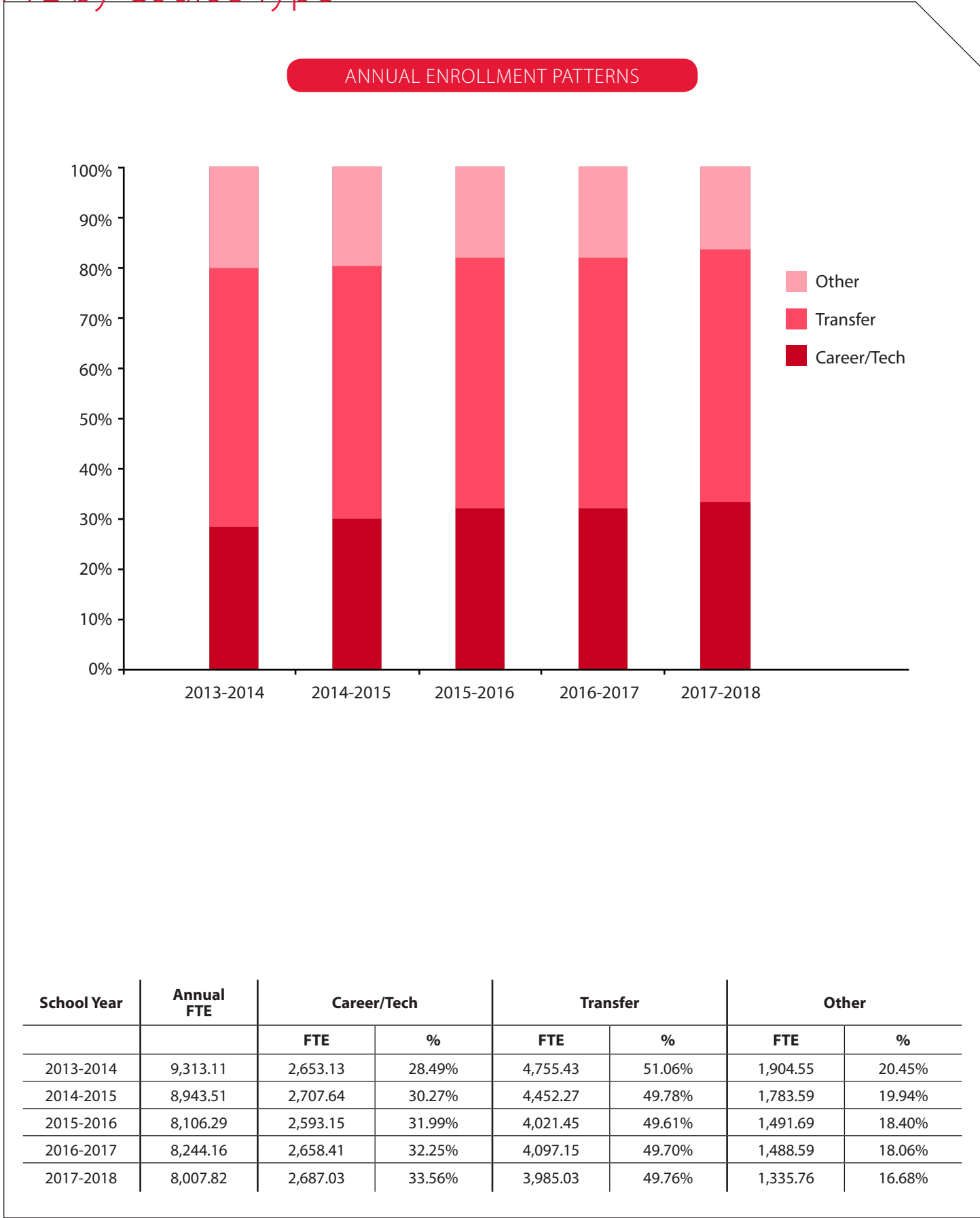
Unduplicated Head Count to FTE Ratio

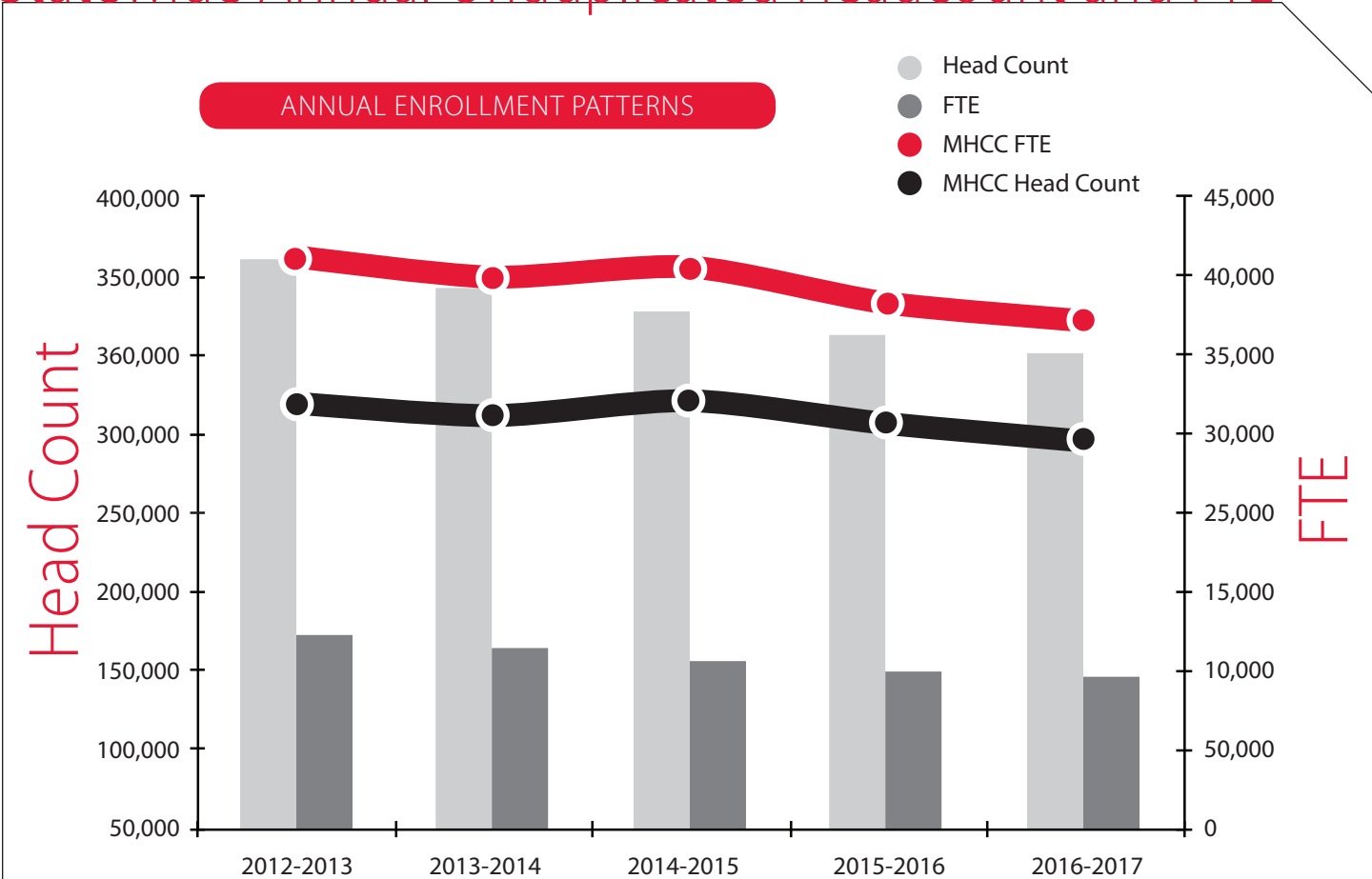
FTE by Course Type



Annual Completions by Type and Year

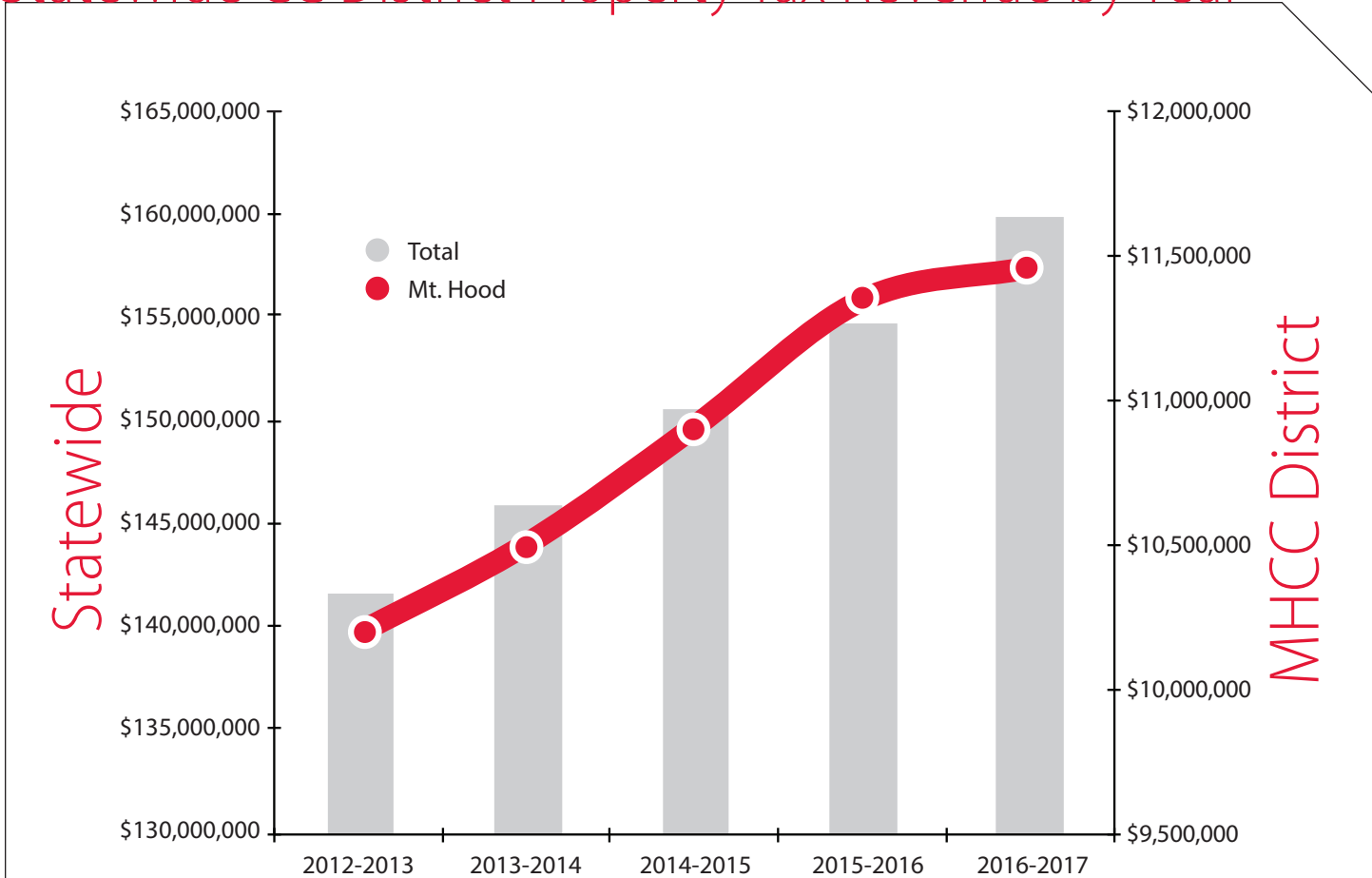


Statewide Annual Unduplicated Headcount and FTE



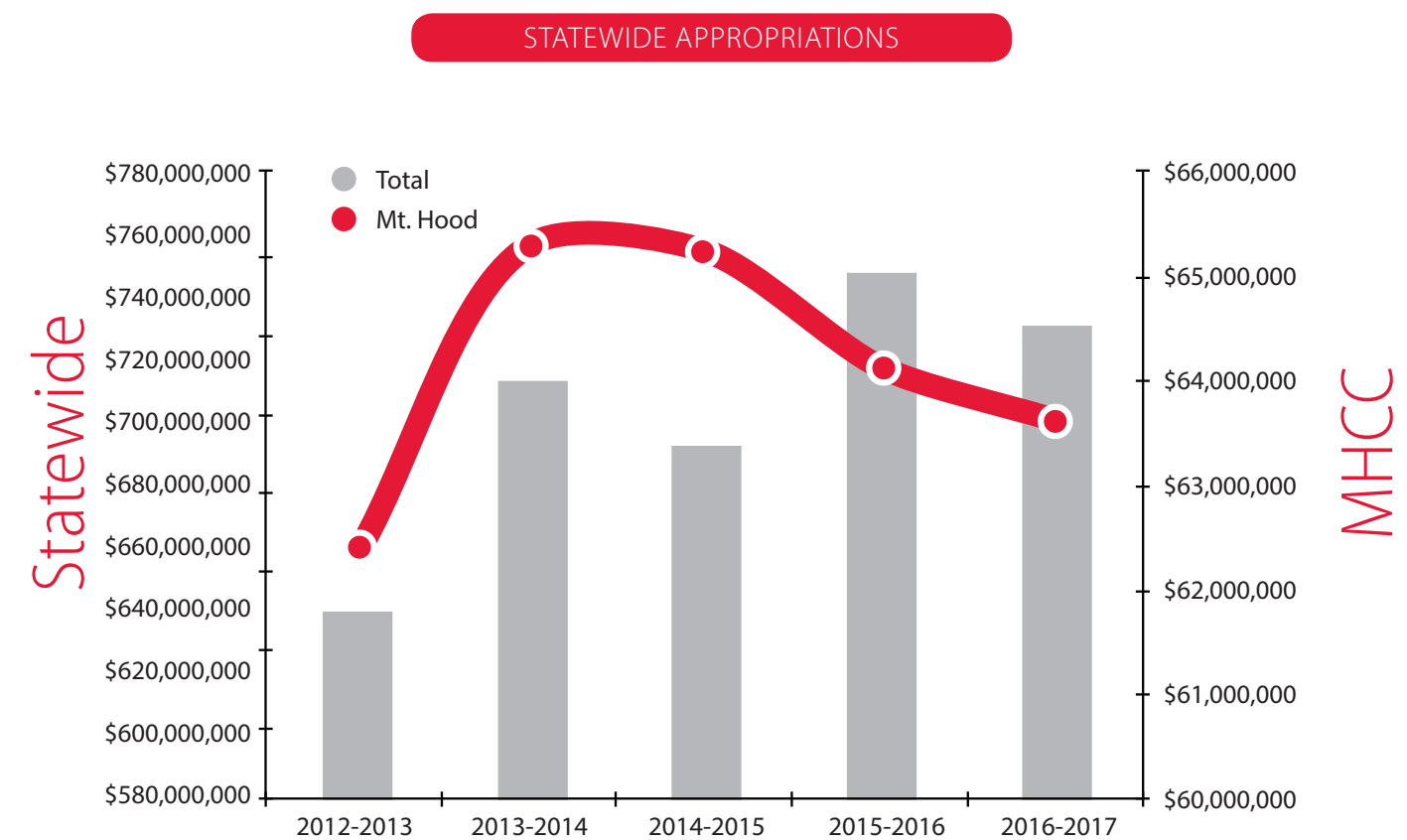

Statewide CC District Property Tax Revenue by Year



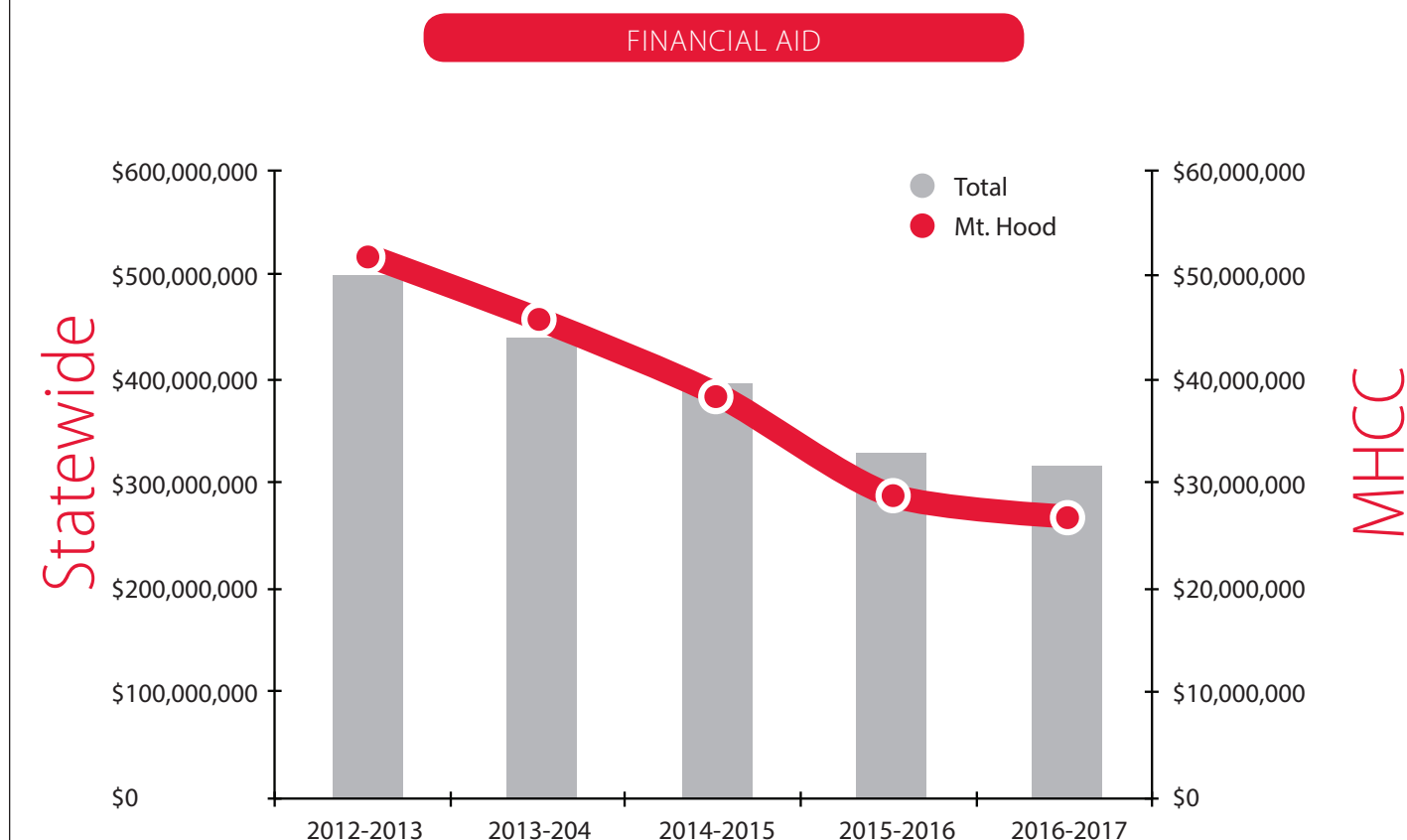

Statewide Appropriations by Year



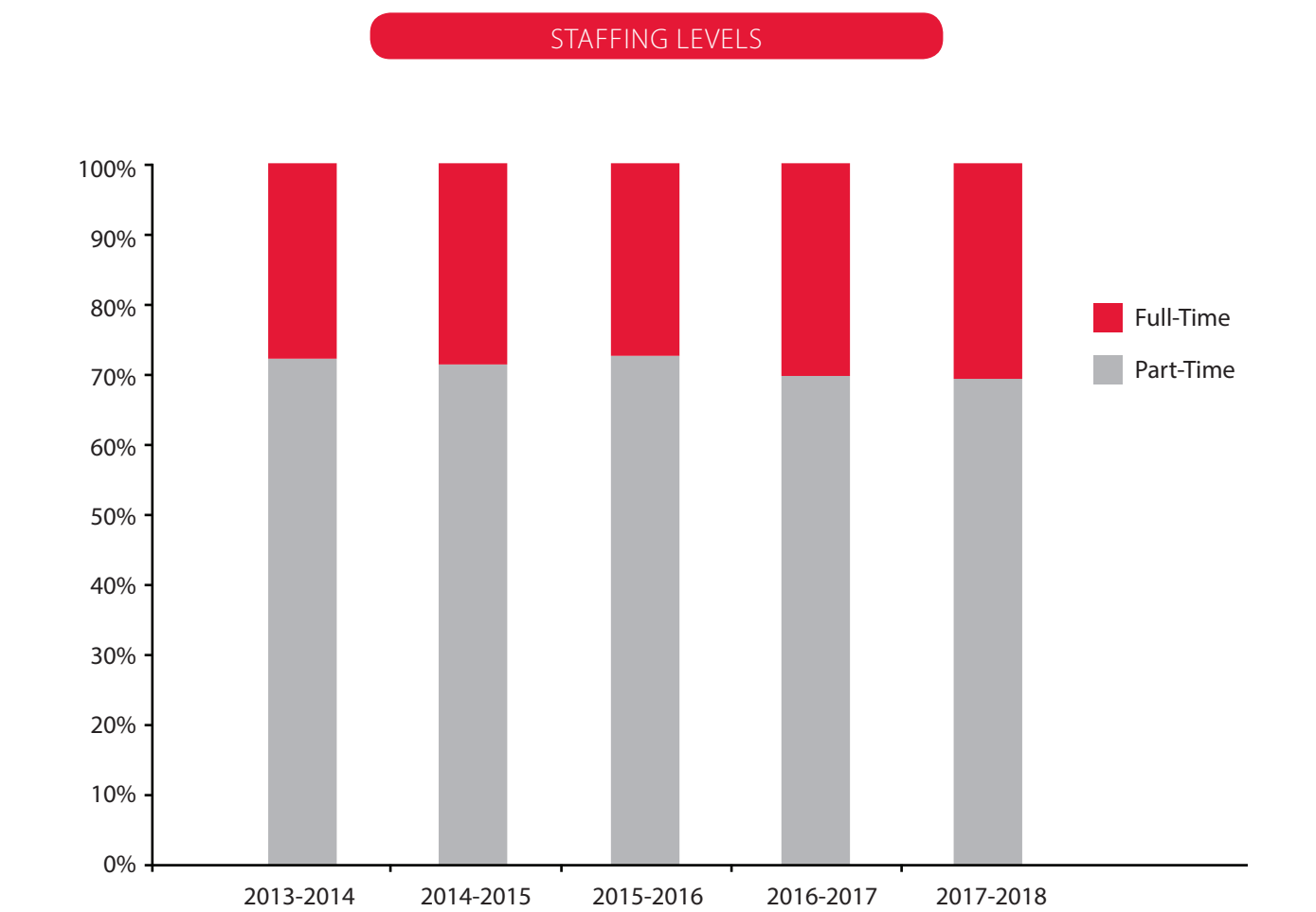
