
Employed As A PTA?

- * Very few resources for finding job posting were given shooting school.
- * Limits in pediatric job opportunities.

- * None that I can think of.
- * Lack of mentorship with new employment.
- * Not many places want new grads
- * My employment search was more of a transition from my final clinical to my current job. I believe this was due to the fact that I was well prepared from MHCC to enter the work force, and due to the fact that MHCC is a respected PTA program that is desirab
- * I interviewed for, and was offered employment at the only facility I applied to. I was very fortunate to encounter no barriers. I was hired by a facility where I did a rotation, so I would suggest that students treat each of their clinical rotations as a
- * I have not yet looked for a job as a PTA. Due to some unexpected opportunities to pursue a couple of financial investments which will pay off dividends long into my future, I have decided to delay looking for PTA employment until this summer.
- * I was able to locate a job shortly after obtaining my PTA license. There are elements of my job that I enjoy but am hoping to work at an outpatient clinic and there were none available in the area when I began my job search.

Is there anything else you'd like to tell us to help enhance the preparation of future MHCC PTA graduates or those exploring this as a career option?

- * Train more with appropriate exercise, understanding compensations, progressions of therex and balance. More tools in the therex toolbox
- * I was very prepared.
- * Remain up to date on techniques being used in clinics. I felt that was one of the weakest links we had in school; not only was I not up to date on manual techniques, but there were many out of date exercises and modalities we learned that could have been
- * More in depth explanations of various injuries/diagnosis and what interventions to use and WHY.
- * None
- * No, I am overall very satisfied with my experience at MHCC. I may have a different opinion when I start working in the field, but I won't know that until it happens.
- * More practice and education on documentation. Overall had a great experience at MHCC and enjoying growing in my skills and experience.

- * None that I can think of.
- * Teach patient documentation based on codes (ex 97110, 97116)Be realistic with students and tell them many of them will most likely start out working at SNF's
- * More practice on specific charting systems (Epic) that are in high demand and a good selling point on resumes
- * Continue to prepare students to adapt and be flexible. This is one of the, if not the most, important aspect of my job. I am very happy with my MHCC PTA program experience.
- * Have the resume and interview section be specified to PTA jobs, not just a general overview.
- * There seem to be ample opportunities in SNFs. Having a rotation in a SNF would be great exposure before considering that option.
